Dear Families,

Welcome to St. Elizabeth! The tuition and school fees have been determined for next school year. Your registration to school includes registration for Little Bloomers **Latchkey** Program. Make sure you sign all the forms to complete the dual registration. Registration is \$50.00 per child, but if you choose to take advantage of the early bird registration fee of \$40.00 per child, you have to register **between March 14th and March 18th**. Please, complete the bottom portion and turn it in when you register your child/ren.

Tuition is \$2040.00 for the first child and \$230.00 for each child thereafter. School fees are \$250.00 for the first child and \$190.00 for each child thereafter. Young fives tuition will be \$1000.00 for members of St. Elizabeth Parish and \$1020.00 for non-members. School fees for Young Fives will be \$125.00. Payment plans are an option, but we need to know what you plan to do before we send you an invoice.

Being a Catholic is a life-long commitment. St. Elizabeth Parish is extremely supportive of St. Elizabeth Area Catholic School. They are excellent models of stewardship of time, talent and treasure. We ask for your commitment to help us raise enough funds to make up for the difference between what it actually costs to educate a child and what you will pay for tuition and school fees. Remember that it costs over \$5400 to educate each child, therefore, the Home and School Association and the Boosters Committee need you.

To keep our fees low and affordable, we need everybody's help in **ALL** our fundraising efforts, especially the following:

- **Fall Soup Supper:** This is one of our biggest fundraising events. Parents are needed to help in the preparation of soup before the event. Parents whose children are in K-6 grade **MUST** work in the kitchen on the day of the event by helping warm up soup and washing dishes and cleaning up when the event is over. Parents whose children are in 7 & 8 grade **MUST** work in the gym helping their children serve during the whole evening. This is a wonderful opportunity to teach your children about stewardship of time.
- **Bishop's Big Raffle:** Each family **must** sell at least 10 tickets.
- **Ca\$h 52:** Each family **must** sell tickets. This is a huge moneymaker for our school.
- **Dow Event Center:** If we keep this fundraiser, parents are asked to work at least two events in the year.

We have funds from donations and the Bishop's Charity Ball to provide financial assistance to help families who want to send their children to our school and they could use the help. Forms are available in the office.

I look forward to a successful school year getting to know you and your children!
